Initialization Procedure:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold \wedge & \vee simultaneously until legs stop moving.	Legs move down at half speed of normal operation to the lowest position and rebound 2-5 mm, then stop.
2	Release \wedge & \vee together.	Initialization is complete.

The initialization procedure must be completed before the first running after the desk is installed or parts are replaced. When a re-initialization procedure is needed, unplug the desk from the wall for 30 seconds before re-initializing,

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold \wedge & \vee simultaneously until legs stop moving.	Legs move down at half speed of normal operation to the lowest position and rebound 2-5 mm, then stop.
2	Release \wedge & \vee together.	Initialization in complete.

Move Up and Down:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold \wedge .	Legs move up.
2	Release \wedge .	Legs stop.
3	Press and hold \vee .	Legs move down.
4	Release \vee .	Legs stop.

Set Presets:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold \wedge or \vee to achieve desired desk height.	Legs move worksurface to desired height.
2	Press 'S' then press 1, 2, 3, or 4 within the next 3 seconds.	Position 1, 2, 3, or 4 is saved.

Move Desk Height to a Preset:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold 1, 2, 3, or 4 until legs stop moving.	Legs return to the corresponding position saved.


Switch Display from Inches to Centimeters:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold 'S' then press and hold \vee and hold both down for 3 seconds.	The height information will be changed between centimeters and inches.
2	Release the buttons.	Operation complete.

The display height changes in intervals of 0.5" or 1cm.

Change the Height on the Display to Match the Actual Worksurface Height:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Set the worksurface to any height, recommended at the bottom position.	Measure the actual worksurface height and write down the number in inches or in centimeters.
2	Press and hold 'S' then press and hold \wedge and hold both for 3 seconds.	The first number on the display starts flashing.
3	Release 'S' and \wedge buttons then press \wedge or \vee to change the first digit.	The first digit is being increased or decreased to the first digit of your measurement.
4	Press 'S'.	The second digit on the display starts flashing.
5	Press \wedge or \vee to change the second digit.	The second digit is being increased or decreased to the second digit of your measurement.
6	Press 'S'.	The third digit on the display starts flashing.
7	Press \wedge or \vee to change the third digit.	The third digit is being increased or decreased to the third digit of your measurement.
8	Press 'S'.	Operation complete.



Change the Bottom Position Height:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold ^ or v to achieve desired bottom position height.	Run the legs to the height you want the bottom position to be.
2	Press and hold 'S' then press and hold 1, hold both buttons for 3 seconds.	The letter 'L' shows on the display and means the position is locked at the lowest position that the worksurface can be moved to.
3	Release buttons.	Operation completed.

Unlock the Adjusted Bottom Position Height:

STEP	OPERATION	MOTION
1	Press and hold 'S' then press and hold 1, hold both buttons for 3 seconds.	The letter 'C' shows on the display and means the bottom position is unlocked and can be moved through its full range of motion.
2	Release buttons.	Operation completed.

Error Codes:

CODE	DESCRIPTION	SOLUTION
E01	Leg malfunction	1. Cables came loose, Check if cables are all connected properly. 2. Inner parts of legs are broken, replace legs.
E02	Changing positions too often	Desk has been moving for more than 1 min. Stop moving desk and let system cool down for 10 min.
E03	Weight added exceeds weight capacity	Remove excess weight from desk.
E04	Control box malfunction	1. Use in extreme environments will cause control box to malfunction. Re-initialize the desk. See 'Initialization Procedure'. 2. Stopping initialization process before complete will cause control box to malfunction. Re-initialize the desk. See 'Initialization Procedure'.
E05	Display button is stuck	1. Check the status of the button, if stuck, then push to restore. 2. Replace keypad.
E06	Communication disconnected	1. Cable came loose between keypad/display and control box. Check if the cables are all connected properly. 2. Check to see if the control box works properly.
E07	The height of the desk has dropped below zero on the display	Raise the desk and change the height of desk on the display, see 'Change the Height on the Display to Match the Actual Worksurface Height'.

Trouble Shooting:

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
After connecting the power and pressing up or down the legs have no response.	1. Re-initialize the desk. 2. Check if the cables are all connected properly. 3. Contact Customer Care.
After connecting the power and holding up and down together the legs have no response.	1. Check if the cables are all connected properly. 2. Contact Customer Care.
The legs rise slowly.	1. Check if the input power is the correct rating. 2. Contact Customer Care.
The legs dont move in the direction you're pressing on the keypad.	Contact Customer Care.
Only one leg is moving.	1. Check if the cables are all connected properly. 2. Contact Customer Care.
Legs only move down and not up.	1. Re-initialize the desk. See 'Initialization Procedure'. 2. Contact Customer Care.
Desk moves down on its own.	1. Make sure the added weight does not exceed the weight capacity. 2. Contact Customer Care.
Desk goes into the initialization process frequently.	1. Make sure the added weight does not exceed the weight capacity. 2. Check the noise of the motor. 3. Contact Customer Care.
