The Catholic Children's Hospital Wilhelmstift, part of the Ansgar Group, is the largest children's hospital in Hamburg with 11 specialty departments and 23 medical disciplines under one roof. To support their digital adoption goals, they needed easy-to-use medical carts for patient documentation.

Since the workstations had to be used throughout the hospital, simply upgrading to permanent computer workstations was not the right solution. The Catholic Children's Hospital Wilhelmstift needed a mobile medical cart that was compatible with their existing EHR system and standard thin client and could accommodate paper or a note pad.

"This is especially important for the nurses, doctors and other users, so they don't have to adapt to a new application," said Bettina Stöterau, Digitalization Office, Catholic Children's Hospital Wilhelmstift. "New equipment is easier to use when the application is the same, whether they're using a fixed desk or mobile cart."

For about six months, hospital staff tested various solutions before deciding on Ergotron's StyleView 42 Medical Cart.

"The thin client can be stowed neatly in the storage compartment, and it's mobile so anyone who has to complete patient documentation can use it," said Mark Brede, head of the IT department.

The team valued how the cart is easy to move, can be adapted to the height of each user, and works both standing and sitting.

"The SV42 Medical Cart is quick to understand, easy to handle and just great to use," Stöterau said. "With the help of this cart, everyone can also work in a way that helps prevent back pain, neck pain and other physical impairments."

In addition, both right- and left-hand users can work comfortably with the mouse pad that can be moved to either side of the keyboard. The cart can also be retrofitted with more drawers to transport supplies and care material.





Brede appreciated that the cart adapts to data privacy standards.
